## RALLY FOR THE CURE

The entire Rally Committee and I would like to thank each and every one of you who will make the 2009 Rally for the Cure such a wonderful success. The Saddlebrooke Niners are raising an impressive amount of money to enable the Susan G. Komen Southern Foundation to help hundreds of women in Southern Arizona who face the challenge of fighting breast cancer. As before, we have designated that 75% of all monies raised stay here in Southern Arizona.

There have been concerns about the \$37 that was collected by the Niners. A breakdown of exactly where this money goes may be helpful.

\$20 will be sent to Rally for the Cure Headquarters to cover expenses – closest to the pin prizes, pink ribbon golf balls, Rally pins, tote bags, pin flags, visor clips and printed material. We opted not to sign up to receive a

magazine (Golf for Women is out of Print), so the money that would have gone to that also goes to Susan G. Komen for the Cure.

\$13 is for lunch.

\$4 is being used for our expenses (programs and other printed materials, favors, table decorations, memorials, and prizes for winners on each course. ) In addition, many committee members paid for materials themselves.

In light of our current economic times, I can understand concerns about expenses, which is why the fee was kept the same as last year. I hope that this breakdown is helpful.

## Introducing Michael Bennett ~ Outside Invitationals

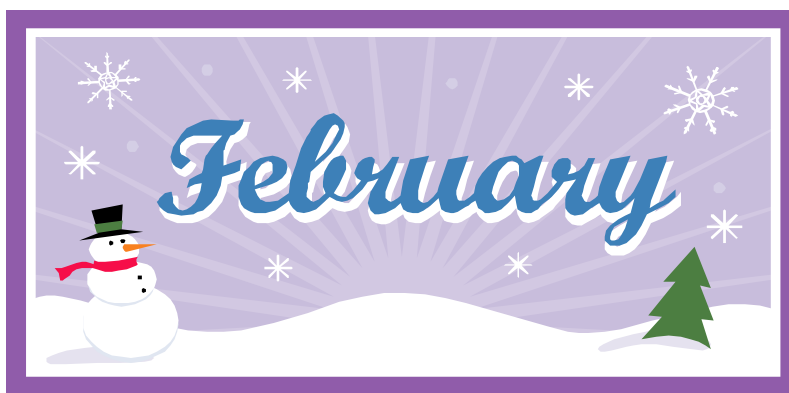
