DECORATIVE ROCK AREAS

Pro Bernie Eaton has asked that a revision be issued to the first clarification on the Decorative Rock Areas ruling.

Effective today, 18 June 2009, the ruling will be as follows:

In the decorative rock areas of our courses if your ball lands anywhere in this area, including in a bush, you receive free relief of up to one (1) club length, no closer to the hole.

This rule will apply ONLY if you FIND your ball. If you are not able to find your ball, then you must proceed under the **lost ball** procedures. It is recommended that if you think you are in a bush in the decorative rock areas to play a provisional ball from the point you are at until your first ball is found. This will negate the need to return to the point from where the original ball was hit.
