

## NOVEMBER RULES REMINDER

The Niners' President's Cup is individual Match Play. **USGA Rule 2** - in part –states:

“in Match Play a game is played by holes. A hole is won by a player who holes out with the fewer strokes. A player may concede a hole at any time. A match is won when a player leads by a number of holes greater than the number remaining to be played.”

If you are playing in the President's Cup, **please be familiar with USGA Rule 2**, it will help you understand the procedures.

**“Different Strokes for Different Folks”** (we call them Pops):

Snoopy and Woodstock enjoy squaring off head- to- head against each other. Today, they are competing in Match Play. Woodstock has a 9 hole course handicap of 20 and Snoopy's handicap is 14. How do you balance the playing field? Snoopy has to give Woodstock 6 “pops”. The pops are applied to the lowest handicap holes designated on the scorecard for the course they are playing.
