Maybe you have a birthday or anniversary coming up. For sure the Holidays are almost here. Did you have a “gadget” in mind but were not sure if it could be used in League play????

Well, just in time for any of the above, the SaddleBrooke HOA#1 Golf rules(local rules) were revised on September 8, 2007, to read:

Distance Measuring Devices

“For all routine play at HOA#1 courses, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. A player is not permitted to use a distance measuring device that is designated to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.).”

Prior to the revision it was stated that the SMGA, SBWGA and SB Ladies Niners currently do not allow use of distance measuring devices during their sponsored events.

You may wish to refer to USGA Rule, 14-3.
